Program Descriptions – Triple P Programs 🍰					
Triple P Primary Care - Primary care is a private and quick way to get Triple P support that targets the exact parenting problem or issue you are having, (e.g. tantrums, fighting, going shopping; and supports skill development e.g. eating independently, toilet training or staying in bed at night.) You (and your partner if you wish) will meet with a Triple P provider about four time. Each session usually takes between 15-30 minutes. You'll go home with tip sheets to remind you of the strategies you've chosen.					

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#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS**

Art in the Park (1 to 6 years) This program welcomes parents, caregivers and children to be inspired by the process of creating masterpieces together, using recyclable materials and loose parts found in nature.

**Creative Chefs** (2 to 6 years) This program invites parents, caregivers and children to participate in fun and interactive early learning experiences while preparing healthy and nutritious food. Resources on healthy eating and nutrition will be made available for families.
