Program Descriptions – Triple P Programs

Triple P Fearless (2 to 6 years) Fear-Less Triple Parenting was developed to help anxious children and their parents. Everyone experiences anxiety, stress, and worry from time to time. However, for some, anxiety, stress, and worry can overwhelm day-to-day lives. This Fear-Less series offers parents support with:

- Learning what anxiety is and how it develops?
- Develop strategies to encourage children to express, tolerate, and manage their upsetting emotions.
- Create a step-by-step coping plan

Triple P Primary Care - Primary care is a private and quick way to get Triple P support that targets the exact parenting problem or issue you are having, (e.g. tantrums, fighting, going shopping; and supports skill development e.g. eating independently, toilet training or staying in bed at night.) You (and your partner if you wish) will meet with a Triple P provider about four times. Each session usually takes between 15-30 minutes. You'll go home with tip sheets to remind you of the strategies you've chosen.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Art in the Park (1 to 6 years) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children to be inspired by the process of creating masterpieces together, using recyclable materials and loose parts found in nature.

Creative Chefs (2 to 6 years) This program invites parents, caregivers, and children to participate in fun and interactive early learning experiences while preparing healthy and nutritious food. Resources on healthy eating and nutrition will be made available for families. **Registration required**

Family Fun Outdoors (0 to 6 years) This program provides the opportunity to visit local parks and outdoor spaces. Parents, caregivers, and children can come and enjoy some fun and interactive outdoor physical activities. Studies show that children who play outdoors are happier and healthier.

Family Stay & Play (0 to 6 years) Parents, caregivers, and children are welcome to engage in a variety of fun early learning experiences that build positive relationships. A selection of materials will be available for you to play and learn together while providing parents and caregivers with an opportunity to connect with others.

Fun with Science (1 to 6 years) Every child is a born scientist! This program offers fun, hands-on, interactive, and educational science experiments and ideas for the whole family.

Goodnight Story (1 to 6 years) Come dressed in pajamas and bring your favorite snuggle toy and be ready for a “Good night story” to finish your fun-filled day.

Let’s Talk (0 to 6 years) Parenting is not always easy and it helps to know we are not alone. This program provides time for parents/caregivers to come together to network and share their parenting experiences and challenges. Community partners may also join to offer their expertise. Settle in for an hour just for you!

Move & Groove (0 to 6 years) This program provides an opportunity for parents, caregivers, and their children to engage in active play that supports the development of gross motor skills while having fun. Through a variety of experiences together, we will stretch, bend, and move to music to support healthy living.

Musical Babies (0 to 12 months) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and babies to experience music together. Families will gather and sing songs, learn rhymes, and use a variety of musical instruments, props, and materials.

Nature & Me (0 to 6 years) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children outside to explore what nature has to offer. We invite families to discover, appreciate, and respect nature through discovering sights, sounds, smells, and touch along the way. There may be an opportunity to see animals and wildlife in their natural environment.
